Features of the Competition:

- 1. Separate competitions will be held for S8 Civil students and all other students.
- 2. Attractive cash prizes for winners and participation certificates for all. First Prize: ₹4,000, Second Prize: ₹3,000, Third Prize: ₹2,000 (Prizes will be award ed in both groups.).
- 3. The competition will consist of 100 multiple-choice questions (MCQs) with special "star questions" to resolve tie-breakers. No negative marking will be applied.
- 4. 50% of the questions will be repeated from previous years' question papers.
- 5. Registration fee: ₹50 per participant.
- 6. Tentative date and time: February 12, 2025, from 1:15 PM to 2:00 PM.
